Lurleen Worthington and James McComb Are ALL-IN for Plumstead Township Board of Supervisors

Plumstead Township, PA. Fresh off their Municipal Primary election victory on May 20th, Lurleen Worthington and Jim McComb are “ALL-IN” for the General Election on November 4th 2025.
